


Most significantly I was notified in October that the Upper Skagit Library District is on the list of recommended projects for the Library Capital Improvement Program. We were 1 of 15 projects selected out of a total of 33 applications. If the funding is authorized by the Washington State Legislature the Upper Skagit Library District will receive \$209,273.00.

The total amount of grants received in 2020 is \$224,725.00. After reviewing the submitted bids, the USLD Board of Trustees awarded the New Library Tenant Improvement to Trico Company. They are a local company located in Burlington with a good reputation and lots of positive references concerning similar work.
