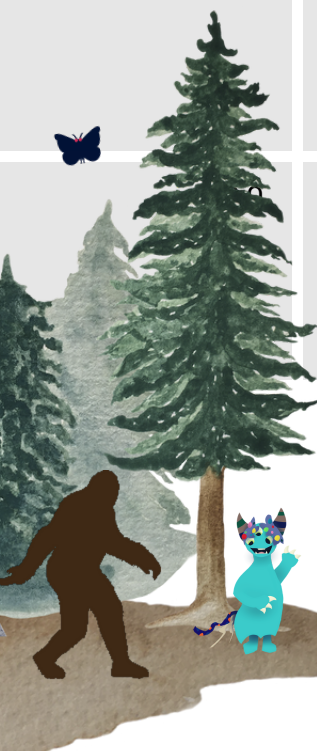

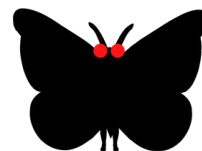


# TEEN PROGRAMS
